Are There Holes In Your Bible?

Nearly every new version of the Bible in print today is based upon Greek manuscripts that are missing many words, phrases and even entire verses. In this pamphlet you will find listed over 200 of the altered verses. All of the **bold underlined** portions of these verses are missing from the Westcott and Hort Greek text. Any verse that is **circled** and **red** is completely missing.

Look up these verses in your Bible and check for yourself. Without knowing it, you may be using a Bible that is full of holes.

WH Greek Text substitutes another word or words

If you have discovered that your Bible is full of holes, I suggest that you put it on the shelf and buy a King James Version (KJV). It will contain every one of these deletions.

The reason the KJV is different is because it was translated from Greek manuscripts within the Majority Greek text family, not the Westcott and Hort Greek text family. About ninety percent of the 5,000+ ancient Greek manuscripts available today are in the Majority Greek text family. The other ten percent form the Westcott and Hort (WH) Greek text family on which most new versions are based.

Though scholars claim that the Westcott and Hort text is "older," this does not mean it is better. It is outnumbered 9-1. Scholars also claim that no major doctrines are affected — the <u>deletions</u> show otherwise as you can see for yourself. Why use a Bible that is full of holes?

Note: The 1881 Westcott and Hort Greek N.T. was used for this com-parison. While this list of deletions is not comprehensive, a majority of them have been noted.
